


"We must lay three **BRILLIANT** traps!"

"For emergencies!"


"Haha! Yum!"

“What?”






"How did you know that there were **THREE** unniappams left, Sooraj?" asked Ammachai. "And HOW did you know they were hidden in the **OVEN**?"


